

A message from Mrs. Heller:

Thank you parents/guardians for all your support in assisting your child/children with distance learning. We know it is challenging for all involved. You are appreciated for all you do!!! I would like to give a shout out to all of our teachers and staff. They are working very hard to meet the needs of our students and their families.

We are hoping to start hybrid soon. We do not have a start date yet. Below is some information on what hybrid learning will look like as well as some information for those choosing to School at Home instead of participating in hybrid learning. We ask that you commit to one or the other until Nov. 9th our quarter break.

### **CRPS Hybrid Instructional Information**

- Students will attend either Mondays and Thursdays or Tuesdays and Fridays for in person learning. There will be about half a class in each group.
- We balanced classes as evenly and as best we can. We did not follow the guidelines of A-K and L-Z in all classrooms in order to balance them and to keep families together etc. We will be getting that information to you soon on which day your student/s will be attending. Please expect a school messenger phone call this week.
- Teachers will teach as much content as they can during the day that they are in attendance. For example, with the Monday group they will teach multiple lessons per content area and do examples with the students. The work that goes along with those lessons will be sent home with your student/s to complete the next day at home along with some Lexia time and other online activities the teacher may assign.
- Wednesdays will look similar to how they look now. Teachers will do some live sessions virtually with your child, they will have specialists virtually, and they will have asynchronous activities to complete.
- When the Monday group comes back on Thursday, the teacher teaches content lessons again, collects work completed while at home, and gives the work to complete on their Friday at home.
- The same applies to Tuesday and Friday students as does to Monday and Thursday students.
- I will post protocols in another post for in school safety guidelines.
- We have posted for an at home teacher for those choosing to keep their child/children at home learning. I will let you know when we get that position hired. Their time will look similar to what it looks like now most likely with more asynchronous time than they have at this time.
- We will ask that you commit to either scenario until Nov. 9th.
